SCG is accelerating the path to Net Zero through SCG Net Zero Roadmap - reducing GHG emissions within operations and expanding solutions beyond. With flagship projects like Saraburi Sandbox, NZAP, and Go Together to empower SMEs and communities to join the low-carbon transition.

SCG Net Zero Roadmap 2050



Phase 1: Short-Term (2020–2030) – Transition to a low-carbon society and reduce Scope 1 and 2 greenhouse gas emissions as The Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi) goal by 25% by 2030 compared to the 2020 base year

Phase 2: Mid-Term (2031–2049) – Focus on expanding low-carbon production technologies, including investing in innovation and research to discover advanced technologies

2050 – Achieved net zero.



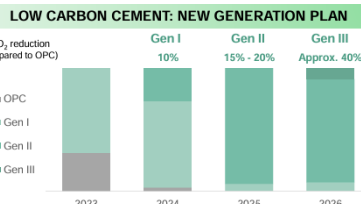
Alternative Fuel

achieving increase proportion of alternative fuels such as biomass and RDF, 29.4% for all business units and 44% for cement operations in Thailand (as of Q1/2025).

In Q1/2025, **SCG's absolute GHG emissions (Scope 1+2) was 6.36 million-ton CO₂**. This keeps SCG on track to achieve our 2030 target, in line with The Science Based Target initiatives (SBTi).

Low Carbon Product

SCG targets revenue from Green Choice products to account for 2/3 of total sales revenue by 2030. In Q1/2025, Revenue from **Sales of Green Choice products was 64,540 MB, accounting for 52% of total Revenue from Sales** and can reduce 260,000 ton CO₂.

Inclusive Society

A “Just Transition” to a “Low-carbon Society” demands collaborative action across all sectors — including government, business partners, SMEs, local communities, youth, and vulnerable groups. SCG is accelerating this transition through impactful, community-driven initiatives.

Saraburi Sandbox

stands out for its success in bringing together the public and private sectors and civil society to **create a PPP (Public-Private-People)** partnership and joins the World Economic Forum’s Transitioning Industrial Clusters initiative, becoming Thailand’s first member of the Forum-led effort driving economic growth, employment and decarbonization globally. **Saraburi Sandbox is the third industrial cluster in ASEAN** and the 21st globally joining this global community.



Net Zero Accelerator Program (NZAP)

aims to **strengthen collaboration among government sector and SME’s entrepreneurs on climate change** and empower their active role in building a low-carbon society, SCG organized a training course from January 17 to March 21, 2025. The program engaged 106 participants, fostering knowledge sharing and practical action to reduce Greenhouse Gas Emissions.



Go Together project by the Federation of Thai Industries and SCG, **aims to promote sustainability in Thailand’s industrial sector**. The project focuses on supporting SMEs to reduce costs, improve production efficiency, and better cope with increasing market competition and global environmental requirements. With a target of 1,200 participants, the program has reached 1,300 participants across 37 provinces and 4 industrial clusters (as of May 2025).
